The competition starts on Saturday 17.5.2025 no earlier than 8:00 AM and on Sunday 18.5.2025 no earlier than 8:00 AM. The office opens one hour before the competition starts and closes one hour after the competition ends.

Registration

The registration deadline is by May 9, 2025, using the attached form sent to the club's email: seura@hyvinkaanratsastajat.net. You will receive your competition number at the office. Vaccination certificates, membership cards, and horse registration certificates must be presented at the competition office upon arrival.

Cancellations

Cancellations must be made by May 16, 2025, by 4:00 PM via email to seura@hyvinkaanratsastajat.net, in which case half of the participation fee will be refunded. After this deadline, entries are considered confirmed. Cancellations after this time must be made via text message to the competition office phone, and no refund will be given without a veterinarian or medical certificate. Certificates must be sent within the following week to seura@hyvinkaanratsastajat.net. Uncancelled entries will be charged the full participation fee.

If a competitor informs the organizer of their cancellation before the registration period ends, the participation fee will be refunded in full, minus any service fees.

Fees:

Pay for as many breed classes as you marked on the registration form, plus breed organization fees and a tail fee/office fee (for all horses).

Tail Fee/Office Fee

15 euros per pair (rider and horse) for the entire competition.

NSBA and APHA Classes:

A horse cannot participate in both of the following classes:

- Trail and Ranch Trail
- Ranch Riding and Western Pleasure or Hunter Under Saddle
- Ranch Rail Pleasure and Western Pleasure or Hunter Under Saddle
- Trail and Trail in Hand

AQHA Classes

- Trail and Ranch Trail
- Ranch Riding and Western Pleasure
- Working Western Rail and Western Pleasure
- Trail and Trail in Hand

Important Notice:

If you participate in Walk & Jog classes, you cannot compete in classes with canter in the same competition.

NSBA Class Participation:

Participants in NSBA classes must be members of NSBA Scandinavia or USA, and both the horse and the owner must be registered with NSBA USA. For US-approved classes, the rider must also be a member of NSBA USA. Participants in AQHA and APHA official classes must be members of the respective organizations, and the horse must be registered with the respective organization. Riders and horses in the APHA All Breed class do not need to be registered with APHA. Please see the attached guidelines for further membership requirements.

NSBA US-Approved Classes and AQHA Classes

These classes will be combined.

Please note that NSBA Scandinavia only awards High Points for classes listed on their website, e.g., not for Novice classes.

AQHA Junior and Senior classes may be combined into AA classes according to the rules.

Ribbons and Prizes:

NSBA: 3 ribbons per class, with prizes for winners based on the entry fees.

AQHA: 6 ribbons

APHA: 6 ribbons

In other classes at Amateur and Open levels, there may also be material and sponsor prizes.
